Research grants/ Fellowships

RESEARCH PROPOSALS IN HUMAN DEVELOPMENTAL & DISEASE BIOLOGY (DBT)

Remit: Human Developmental & Disease Biology

Applicant eligibility: clinicians/scientists actively engaged in the field of Human Developmental and Disease Biology

Comments: The proposals may encompass any aspect of developmental or disease biology related to pregnancy, foetal/neonatal stages, early years of life in humans or related aspects including *in vitro* and *in vivo* functional studies using suitable cell lines and model organisms respectively. Multicentric consortium mode projects involving both research scientists and clinicians encouraged.

Agency deadline: 31 July 2013

International Collaboration

Japan: INDIA-JAPAN COOPERATIVE SCIENCE PROGRAMME (IJCSPP) (DST/JSPC, Japan)

Remit: to promote bilateral scientific collaboration between Indian and Japanese scientists by supporting joint projects and joint workshops.

Applicant eligibility: Indian and Japanese PIs working in regular capacity.

Comments: scientific areas supported include Fundamental Sciences: Physical and Chemical Systems, Materials and System Engineering: Man-made Systems, Natural Systems: Life Sciences and Bioengineering, Astronomy, Space, Earth System and Sciences, Mathematics and Computational Science

Budget: International return airfare, airport transfers, accommodation, per diem. For joint workshops/ seminars to be organized in India, local travel cost of selected Indian participants and organizing expenses may also be considered for support as per DST norms. Some support for consumables and contingencies may be considered as per DST's norms.

Duration: 2 years

Vietnam: INDO- VIETNAM JOINT CALL FOR COLLABORATIVE PROPOSALS TO SUPPORT MEDICAL, ENVIRONMENTAL AND AGRICULTURAL BIOTECHNOLOGY (INCLUDING ANIMAL AND AQUACULTURE) RESEARCH (DBT/MOST, Vietnam)

Remit: Collaborative proposals to support Medical, Environmental and Agricultural Biotechnology (including Animal and Aquaculture) research

Applicant eligibility: Indian and Vietnamese researchers regularly employed in Indian or Vietnamese public funded institutions that perform R&D activities.

International Exchange

Germany: RESEARCH SCHOLARSHIPS FOR YOUNG RESEARCHERS AND RECENT POST DOCTORAL SCHOLARS (DAAD, GERMANY)

Remit: To undertake short- term research project at one of the German Universities or Research Institutions

Applicant eligibility: 0-6 years since the award of last degree (M.A., M.Sc., M.Phil., etc.) or 0-4 years post PhD currently residing in India with a confirmed acceptance letter from a German Professor.

Budget: Stipend of Euro 1000 for PhD scholars and Euro 750.00 for Master degree holders, return airfare, Compulsory health insurance covered by DAAD

Duration: 1-6 months

Agency Deadline: 1 Oct 2013

Germany: RESEARCH STAYS (DAAD, GERMANY)

Remit: To carry out a research project at a state (public) or state recognized higher education institution or non-university research institute in Germany

Applicant eligibility: University academics and scientists from India on active duty

Budget: The monthly award of upto 2,000 euros, international return airfare

Duration: 1- 3 months

Germany: RE-INVITATION PROGRAMME FOR FORMER SCHOLARSHIP HOLDERS (DAAD, Germany)

Remit: To carry out a research project at a state (public) or state recognized higher education institution or non-university research institute in Germany.

Applicant eligibility: Former DAAD one-year scholarship holders and former scholarship holders who had studied in East Germany (GDR) for at least one year

Budget: The monthly award of upto 2,000 euros, international return airfare

Duration: 1-3 months

Agency Deadline: 1 Oct 2013

USA: CENTER FOR GLOBAL HEALTH SHORT-TERM SCIENTIST EXCHANGE PROGRAM (NIH)

Remit: To promote collaborative research between established U.S. and foreign scientists from low, middle, and upper-middle income countries by supporting, in part, exchange visits of cancer researchers between U.S. and foreign laboratories.

Applicant eligibility: Candidates must have a Ph.D., M.D., or a certified equivalent degree, a minimum of one year postdoctoral experience in cancer research, and an invitation from a qualified host. A qualified U.S. host must be either (a) an investigator in the National Cancer Institute (NCI) Intramural Program, or (b) a Principal Investigator on an NCI research grant (or a grant from another NIH institute for cancer-related research). A qualified non-U.S. host must be an established scientist recognized in the international peer-reviewed literature.

Comments: Results announced within one month of the application deadline.

Duration: upto 6 months.

Agency Deadline: September 1, December 1, March 1, and June 1.

Comments: Funding priority is given to events held in an **EMBC Member State** or **cooperating country**.

Budget: €30,000 funding per event, access to website & poster design services and registration system provided by EMBO
