1. Sealed item rate tenders are invited, on behalf of the Centre Director, NCBS and will be received in the Office of the Civil Maintenance, NCBS from Contractors who have executed works of similar nature and magnitude, for the following work:

2. The period of contract shall commence within 15 days period from the date of issue of work order.
3. **The Contractor should have experience in similar kind of works i.e Civil works with Compound wall fencing works etc..**
4. Tender documents (Non Transferable), consisting of complete specifications, schedule of quantities for various items of work to be done and set of conditions of contract to be complied with by the tenderers whose tender may be accepted can be obtained from the office of the Civil Maintenance, NCBS on any working day between 10:00 Hours to 16:00 Hours on payment of amount mentioned in Para 1 (non-refundable) from **06/11/2020 to 16/11/2020**.
5. Experience of having successfully completed works during the last seven years ending previous day of last date of submission of Tenders. The list of similar works completed with value of each work, addresses of the clients for whom the works were executed should be furnished along with the application for the tender document.

Tender document will be issued only to those who have completed the works of similar nature as below,

(a) One work of similar nature costing Rs.3.86 Lakhs (80% of Rs. 4.83 lakhs)

OR

(b) Two works of similar nature costing Rs. 2.90 Lakhs each (60% of Rs. 4.83 lakhs)

OR

(c) Three works of similar nature costing Rs.1.93 Lakhs each (40% of Rs.4.83 lakhs)

AND

(d) One completed work of any nature (either part of (a,b,c)), or a separate one costing not less than the amount to Rs.1.93 Lakhs with some Central/State Government Organization/ Central Autonomous Body/Central Public Sector undertaking.

The value of executed works shall be brought to current costing level by enhancing actual value of work at simple rate of 7% per annum, calculated from the date of completion to

previous day of last date of submission of tenders.

- 5 (a). Tenderer should have a solvency of Rs. 1.93 Lakhs. Tenderers shall enclose latest valid solvency certificate .
6. The tenderers shall be put in sealed cloth lined cover super scribed with the name of work, NIT number and name of the Tenderer. Tenders will be opened in the presence of intending tenderer, on the due date and time for receipt and opening. (It may be noted that only those covers containing EMD in the prescribed form shall be taken for further consideration and all others, without EMD shall be rejected).

Application for tender document not accompanied by the following is liable for rejection of issue of tender document:-

- (i) Proof of experience in execution of similar nature and magnitude of work as indicated at Para above.
- (ii) Latest Bank Solvency certificate from any scheduled banks of Minimum Value (40% of the Estimate Amount put to Tender of Rs. 1.93 (Lakhs).
- (iii) Performance certificates, GST Number and PAN (Permanent Account Number).
- (iv) Letter of authority in case the application is through authorized person.
- (v) Cost of tender document.
- (vi) Company's profile, Local Office status, Bankers, Manpower and Experience.
- (vii) Valid registration certificate of the firm appropriate class.
- (viii) Valid ESI, PF and GST registration certificates.
- (ix) A List to be furnished for number of qualified technical people in employment and their Qualification.
- (x) Latest income tax clearance certificate.

Note:

1. Application for tender document should be submitted at least one working day before the last date for sale of tender. Late application for the tender document is liable for rejection.
2. The value of executed works shall be brought to correct costing level by enhancing the actual value of work at simple rate of 7% per annum, calculated from the date of completion to the last date of receipt of application for tender
7. As said above tender which should always be placed in sealed covers super scribed with the name of work (as given in para1) will be received by NCBS upto **15:00 Hrs on 18/11/2020** and will be opened in the Civil Maintenance, on the same day at **15:30 hours** onwards in the presence of the tenderers or their representatives who would be present Through VC
8. Tenders are to be on the printed form of the NCBS, which can be obtained on payment of the cost of documents mentioned above in cash/DD of scheduled bank drawn in favour of **NCBS**, Bangalore. The drawings issued with the tender documents should

be returned along with the tender. The Tenderers shall quote rates in figure as well as in words and amounts tendered by them. The amount for each item shall be worked out and requisite total given. All corrections shall be attested by the dated initials of the tenderer. The contractors not tendering for this work after the purchase of the tender documents must return the tender documents and drawings within 15 days of the due date of receipt of the tender. However, the cost the tender documents will not be refunded.

9. Tenders not accompanied by the following are liable to be summarily rejected. Tenderers shall furnish the Earnest Money Deposit which may be in the form of Crossed Demand Draft/Call deposit on the Reserve bank of India or State bank of India. Earnest Money Deposits may also be furnished in the form of Fixed Deposit Receipts issued by and Scheduled Bank and endorsed by the Bank concerned at the disposal of the NCBS.
10. It may be noted that EMD up to a value of Rs. 20.00 Lakhs has to be in the form said above and balance can be in the form of Bank guarantee from any Nationalized Bank.

(a) EMD shall be returned after receipt of Bank Guarantee for Performance Guarantee.

11. The acceptance of the tender will rest with the Centre Director, NCBS who does not bind himself to accept the lowest or any other tender. No reasons will be furnished for the acceptance or rejection of any tender.
12. Canvassing in connection with tender will result in disqualification.
13. Any tender which does not fulfill any of the prescribed conditions will be liable to be rejected.
14. NCBS reserves the right to cancel the tender / alter the scope or reduce quantum of work before issue of work order and the **Tenderer** shall not have any claim what so ever on this account.
15. Rates quoted by the Contractor in item rate tender in figures and words shall be accurately filled in so that there is no discrepancy in the rates written in figures and words. However, if any discrepancy is found, the rates which correspond with the amount worked out by the Contractor shall be taken as correct.
16. If the amount of an item is not worked out by the Contractor or it does not correspond with the rate written either in figures or words, then the rate quoted by the Contractor in words shall be taken as correct.
17. Where the rates quotes by the Contractor in figures and in words tally but the amount is not worked out correctly the rate quoted by the Contractor will be taken as correct and not the amount.
18. Where the rates are not quoted by the Contractor in words and amount is not worked out or not worked out correctly, the rate quoted by the Contractor will be taken as correct.
19. In the event no rate has been quoted for any item / items, leaving space both in figure(s), word(s) and amount blank, it will be presumed that the contractor has included the cost of this / these item(s) in other items and rate for such item(s) will be considered as zero and will be required to be executed accordingly.

20. The Quoted rates shall be inclusive of all the taxes i.e. ESI, PF, ELI, Bonus, GST, levies, duties, cess & profit etc. Payable under respective statues. Deductions as per statues cost be effected from the bill and remitted to the Department concerned.
21. NCBS reserves the right to reject any application for issued of tender document without assigning any reason.
22. The tender whose tender is accepted will be required to furnish performance guarantee of 5% of the tendered amount as per the clause 1 of the condition of contract.
23. The EMD (Earnest Money Deposit) should be drawn in the favors of NCBS for an amount of Rs.9680/-.
24. As per contract, Security deposit of 2.5% of tender value shall be deducted from the running account bills of the work as per the clause 1A of the condition of contract

Bids Validity: Bids shall be valid for 75 days from the date of its submission.

NOTE 1: Each and every page of the offered bid shall bear the dated signature and seal of the contractor.
