2018 JDB TRAVEL AWARDS

The Journal of Developmental Biology (JDB) has announced a call to support early career researchers towards presenting their work at scientific meetings of their choice.

JDB travel grants can be availed by postdoctoral fellows or PhD students working in the area of Developmental biology research to attend an international conference related to Developmental biology in 2018 and to present their research (oral and/or poster presentation).

The scheme offers one travel award of 800 CHF (Swiss Francs).

Call for NCBS/inStem Campus Fellows program

The Academic Office has announced the next call for applications to the NCBS/inStem Campus Fellows program (CFP), to an internal deadline of **11th September, 2017**.

The NCBS/inStem Campus Fellows program is targeted at postdoctoral scientists of exceptional talent, and provides them broad independence and support to carry out their research in a host laboratory at NCBS (www.ncbs.res.in) or inStem (http://instem.res.in). Fellows are expected to drive new research directions in their host laboratories, and to establish themselves as independent scientists.

Campus Fellows are appointed for a period not exceeding 4 years. The Fellowship provides competitive salary and campus housing. Fellows may choose to hold a part of their Fellowship off-campus for collaborative work and training relevant to their program of research.

Selection is on the basis of a proposal developed in close collaboration with the host followed by a public seminar and an interview with the CFP committee.



Call For Proposals ICT (2017) (DBT/RCN, Norway)

Remit: To support collaborative research projects between scientists in Norway and India within the field of ICT (Information and Communication Technology) research including environmental monitoring, smart neighborhoods, sensor networks/IoT, monitoring for safe living, mobility and wireless infrastructure, Artificial intelligence, autonomous and cognitive systems etc.

Applicant eligibility: Principal investigator should be based at a research institution in India.

Budget: Funds equipment costs, manpower, consumables, contingency and international travel related expenses (supports mobility).

Duration: Up to 3 years

ASEAN-India collaborative R&D program (AISTDF)

Remit: To promote collaborative research projects among researchers of India and ASEAN (Association of South East Asian Nations) countries (http://asean.org/asean/asean-member-states/) in all disciplines of natural sciences, medicine, health, Mathematics, electronics & IT, science & technology

Applicant eligibility: Faculty based at eligible Indian/ ASEAN universities/ publicly funded research institutes. The total number of participants on each side should not exceed two.

Budget: Funds mobility of researchers from India to partnering ASEAN member countries and vice versa. Limited funding for manpower, accessories, add-ons to existing equipment, chemicals and consumables.

Call For Proposals - India-Japan Cooperative Science Programme (IJCSP, Japan)

Remit: To promote collaborative research projects among researchers of India and Japan in disciplines including Life Sciences and Bioengineering, Fundamental Sciences, Materials and System Engineering, Astronomy, Space, Earth System and Sciences and Mathematics and Computational Science.

Applicant eligibility: Application must include one Indian and one Japanese Principal Investigator. Principal investigator should be based at a research institution in India/Japan.

Budget: Funds mobility of researchers from India to Japan and vice versa. This includes cost of international airfare to and from the designated research location, visa fee, airport taxes, overseas medical insurance premium for the approved visit duration and airport transfers in India. Funding is also available for joint workshops/seminars to be organized in India.

International Exchange

International Exchanges Scheme (The Royal Society, UK)

Remit: To strengthen the collaboration between scientists in the UK and overseas. This scheme funds either a one-off short visit to explore opportunities for building lasting networks or for bilateral visits to strengthen emerging collaborations.

Eligibility: The lead applicant (UK based scientist and/or project leader) and the co-applicant (overseas based scientist and/or project leader) must have a PhD and hold a permanent or fixed-term contract in an eligible university or research institute, which must span the duration of the project. This scheme accepts applications for collaborations with all countries outside of the UK.

Budget: Funds for contribution towards travel, subsistence and research expenses. Up to £3,000 for travel up to 3 months, for multiple visits: up to £6,000 within 1 year and up to £12,000 within 2 years.

Duration: Up to 3 months, 1 year or 2 years

Budget: Rs. 55,000/- per month (consolidated), research grant: Rs. 2,00,000/- per annum
